Subject: Incident with BLM member

On 031116 at 0123 hrs Officer Allgood was dispatched to an intoxicated / sick person call at the stage area of Market Square. Upon arrival we located the individual sitting on Wall in front of the TVA fountains. A female who was with the male stated he was initially passed out and when he came to, was incoherent. Due to his level of intoxication we called for an ambulance to transport and we were advised Rural Metro did not have one to send. Dispatch then advised us that they could not provide an ETA for one to be transported. I made the decision to transport the male to Ft. Sanders hospital myself instead of waiting 20 - 40 minutes for an ambulance. As we placed the male in the back of my cruiser, suspect David Hayes approached us with cell phone in hand and wanted to know how to get in contact with the male. I told him he could call Ft. Sanders hospital, but if he wasn't a family member, they would not release any information to Hayes.

Hayes then asked for my badge number and when I asked him why he stated that he did not trust us at which time I began to get into my cruiser to leave. Hayes then stated "If anything happens to this brother, I will find you and fuck you up". Hayes then identified himself as being with Black Lives Matter and asked if we knew what they were doing across the country, at which time I told him he was standing in the street and needed to get on the side walk. Haynes began to raise his voice and refused a lawful order to get out of the street at which time Officer Allgood and myself placed him custody for obstructing the roadway and disorderly conduct. During the arrest and incident there were multiple individuals behind us that attempted to approach when our backs were turned and recorded the incident on cell phones. Another unknown white male who was recording the incident wanted to question our

actions, but we left the scene. Hayes was charged with Obstructing Roadway and Disorderly Conduct. The original male in my cruiser was taken to Ft. Sanders hospital and admitted for treatment. While at intake, Hayes told Officer Allgood that he was coming after him. When questioned further about that statement, Hayes restated that he was coming after Officer Allgood legally. Hayes also stated that he hoped that Knox County would "Fuck him up" while he was in the jail so he could sue them, and Hayes also made statements that he could be the next Freddie Grey.

The entire incident (audio only due to vehicle position) was captured on my in-car video, which starts at 01:27:44, car # 21328. Officer Allgood's video was also activated for the encounter with Hayes at 01:35, car # 21449.
